VISITORS SERVICES AND HELPFUL HINTS FOR NAVIGATING SHOW FINDING EFD @ RODMAN LOTT & SON FARMS,

It is located just south of the village on route 414. Visitors traveling the NYS THRUWAY should use either EXIT 42-GENEVA or EXIT 41-WATERLOO & SENECA FALLS. Once off the NYS THRUWAY follow the signs put up by the Seneca County Sheriff's Department to the Empire Farm Days site. Getting through the village, visitors will be assisted by the Seneca Falls Village Police Department. Once at the site the NYS Police Department and Seneca County Sheriff's Department handle the thousands of cars looking to get in, get parked and get started seeing the show. (2973 Rte 414, Seneca Falls, NY 13148)

GETTING AROUND SHOW IS EASY

For the convenience of our visitors-5 trams operate in the following locations this year: In the North parking lots, with a drop off at the North end of Empire Blvd: In the South parking lots, with a drop of at the South end of Empire Blvd: One continually within the show on Empire Blvd, between the North and South ends of the show, and a new tram running east and west this year in the center of the show.

FLYERS WELCOME!

There will be a continuous shuttle back and forth to the Fingerlakes Regional Airport (315.568.0110). Flying farmers can land at the airport, adjacent to the show site, and be at the show within minutes. Folks can pick up the shuttle back to airport at lot #928.

LOCAL GROUP PROVIDES INFO ON AREA:

Visitors can stop by the Seneca County Tourism booth in the Northeast Main Tent to get information on the area attractions.

WELCOME CENTER:

Stop by the Welcome Center and grab a complimentary bag of NY – grown potato chips, meet the growers and their families who bring you this show year after year. Visit the displays of

potatoes and get new ideas for cooking America's Favorite Vegetable – the potato. Other highlights in this area include a historical view of the 75-year old Empire Farm Days, and answers to your questions about displays, exhibits and schedules.

HANDICAPPED VISITORS

Handicapped parking areas are reserved at all four corners of the exhibit area. Enter at any main vehicle gate and attendants will direct vehicles with handicapped tags to designated areas.

Since Empire Farm Days is a pedestrian show it is important to limit the use of motorized vehicles to handicapped individuals who require this type of vehicle for use at the show. Handicapped persons who need to use a motorized vehicle **MUST** register at the Show Office upon entering the grounds. Access will **ONLY** be granted to people providing an approved handicapped permit. The vehicle may not exceed a speed of 5 mph. Vehicles must stay on the roadways and may not be driven into tents, demonstration areas, or onto exhibits. Only approved uses of vehicles will be permitted (i.e. no underage drivers, no riders, other restrictions apply.) These efforts are designed to make the show safe and accessible for **ALL** our visitors.

Handicapped restroom facilities are available at the east and west ends of the exhibit area.

FIRST AID SERVICES:

North Seneca Ambulance provides EMT services during the show to ensure the health and safety of all visitors. First Aid stations are located at the North and South ends of Empire Blvd and on the west side of show, just north of Empire Building.

FOOD & DRINK PLENTIFUL: Famous BBQ, Ice Cream, Hots and Hamburgers.
